NOTES

- (a) Required Freshman Bible Course; course number can end in 1, 2, or 3 for 1/2/3 credits.
- (b) Required Sophomore Bible Course; course number can end in 1,2, or 3 for 1/2/3 credits.
- (c) Recommended for all first-time college students. Required for all full-time freshmen with a GED or placed in a Developmental Course(except MTH063), and of full-time transfer and returning students with a college GPA less than 2.00. (Limit 15 per class)
- (d) Credit is optionally available for music groups for a maximum of 2 semesters.
- (e) Required tutoring based upon class performance
- (f) Minimum of a C in prerequisite course, satisfactory score on ASSET exam, or a minimum of a 19 on the English portion (as appropriate) on the ACT required.
- (g) Minimum of C in prerequisite course, satisfactory scores on ASSET exam, or minimum of 21 on math portion of the ACT required.
- (h) Required Freshmen Greek Course
- (i) Required Sophomore Greek Course
- (j) 1st half of course - continues through first eight weeks
- (k) 2nd half of course -continues through last eight weeks
